The Willow River Rod and Gun Club of New Richmond Wisconsin consists of membership mainly from Western Wisconsin and Eastern Minnesota. The club promotes the shooting sports, wildlife habitat improvement, outdoor education, and other outdoor recreational opportunities.

Our organization is proud to offer two \$1,000.00 scholarships to graduating seniors who wish to pursue an education in the field(s) of Environmental Science and or Natural Resource Management/Conservation. The Scholarship is available to students who enroll in either a two or four year accredited institution. To apply students must submit a copy of their high school transcripts along with a two page (typed/double spaced) paper outlining why he or she should be considered for our scholarship, and a completed application. In addition, the student must submit one letter of recommendation along with his or her narrative, application, and transcripts. To be eligible, the applicant must have a declared major in one of the fields of study in the page titled "Qualifying areas of study"

Consideration for these scholarships will first go to the membership of the Willow River Rod and Gun Club, then to graduating seniors of the New Richmond, Somerset, and Osceola School Districts.

Requirements for reimbursement are as follows:

Students who are awarded the scholarship must maintain a GPA of 2.50 throughout their first semester (1/2 year) of coursework. Transcripts must then be submitted to Ron Roettger- PO Box 22, Star Prairie, WI 54026 The Clubs selection committee will review the student's grades, and then issue a check to the scholarship recipient in the amount of \$1,000.00 (presumably in January)
